How can students access the digital curriculum from home?

While we recommend that students use laptops or desktop computers for best results, all of the lessons and assessments within AES are optimized for mobile use. Because of this, they can access it from tablets and phones that have data or wifi enabled.

How can I log in to complete work from home?

1. Go to the browser on your device and connect to data or WiFi
2. In your browser URL bar, type in learn.aeseducation.com
3. Sign in if you already have an account
4. Complete your assigned work

What should I do if I don't already have an AES account?

1. Go to the browser on your device and connect to data or WiFi
2. In your browser URL bar, type learn.aeseducation.com
3. Click the orange "Create New Student Account" button at the bottom of the login screen
4. Type in the enrollment code provided by your teacher and follow the prompts to create your account
