Behavioral Health vs. Mental Health

You've more than likely heard the term mental health before. Often, behavioral health and mental health are used in the same way. However, the terms don't really mean the same thing.

Mental health focuses on a person's psychological state. For example, if someone is living with bipolar disorder, the mental health aspect only investigates the chemical imbalance in the brain that causes bipolar disorder and how it affects the way a person's mind is functioning.

Behavioral health addresses all aspects of mental wellness, including mental health, substance abuse, behavior and habits (such as eating and exercise routines), and other external forces. Using the same example of bipolar disorder, behavioral health would also address the manic and depressive episodes, the triggers that cause these episodes, and much more.

3 Ways to Use the Electronic Worksheet Exports

- Export the worksheets on the due date and have a record of all your students who finished the assignment on time.
- Enable the student export after a classroom discussion to review the correct answers. Students take notes and make corrections, then export the PDF hard copy. This can be used to study or for open-note tests.
- Students export their completed worksheets and upload the PDF hard copy to your school's LMS.




